

# San Dimas Stops Schurr in Opener

LA VERNE — San Dimas High's indoctrination into varsity football was a sure success at Bonita Stadium Thursday night.

The Saints romped to a 28-0 victory over Schurr, another

new school making its first appearance at the varsity level.

Despite numerous penalties, San Dimas displayed an awesome offense at times during the game. Wayne Moses, the Saints' letterman running back, led the charge.

Moses scored at 4:57 of the second quarter on an 85-yard jaunt to get the Saints started.

Later in the second quarter with the score 6-0, Moses carried the ball for a 38 yard gain to the Schurr two yard line. After quarterback Jeff Nelson unsuccessfully tried from the two, Moses carried it in to make the score 12-0. Nelson threw to Greg Newborn for the two point conversion.

The Saint defense looked good throughout the game as Schurr was never in the posi-

tion to score until late in the fourth quarter. Standouts for the Saints were Bob Rollins, Rick Surdick, and Newborn.

In the third quarter the Saints took advantage of a short Schurr punt and had good field position at the 41. The Saints scored after a drive that took nine plays and featured the running of Moses, Randy Spahr, and the pass catching of end Rollins. The drive was capped on quarterback Steve Barnard's one-yard plunge at 4:54 of the third quarter. The extra point attempt was blocked.

In the fourth quarter while sitting on a 20-0 lead the San Dimas defense stiffened and did not allow Schurr to get one first down until, with one minute remaining, quarterback, Robert Esquivel passed to end Bob Nomura for 23 yards. Esquivel continued to move against the Saints until his drive failed with 20 seconds remaining in the game and Schurr at the San Dimas 15 yard line.

The Saints final touchdown came on a pass play from Nelson to Newborn at 9:11 of the fourth quarter, covering 40 yards. Nelson ran for the two point conversion.
